c. Create employment opportunities among the villagers through suitable projects.

d. Promote saving and loan schemes to enhance the purchasing capacity of the underprivileged.

e. Organise benefit schemes and cooperative underwriting

f. Employment required personnel and to pay reasonable wages or honorarium or out of pocket expenses accordingly for the services rendered to the society.

g. Build up available resources, skills, talents, monetary contributions or gifts in kind, so as to organise production-combining units of various kinds.

h. Establish and manage educational centres, self employment loan schemes and public welfare schemes.

i. Administer the funds, assets properly for the best interest of the society as decided best by the Executive committee.

j. Invest the funds not immediately required.

k. Borrow and raise funds with or without security.

l. Take up and course of activity in accordance with the aims and object of the society subject to Social Work Society Registration Act 1975 at all times.

6. i) The organisation shall strive together with members to take part in the activities of the organisation in accordance with their interest

ii) The Executive committee of the organisation shall chalk out the policies and courses of action from time to time for the progress of the organisation.

7. The President shall be responsible to give directions for the activities of the organisation.

8. The President shall be the person who will sue and be sued for and on behalf of the organisation.

9. All women aged about 18 years shall be eligible to become a member of the organization.

11) An application for membership shall be made in prescribed form and the committee may accept or reject the said application without giving any reasons.

10) Entrance fee Rs. 10/- annual subscription Rs. .

11) Members who fail to remit the subscription even ultimately for two years will be removed from the membership

12) If any of the member is believed to act against the interest of the society, he or she may be removed from membership by the managing committee. The decision of the managing committee will be final.

13) 1) Members have right to vote in General Body Meeting.

11) Members are eligible to contest in the Executive committee.

14. President:

1. The President shall be Executive head of the organization

2. His advice shall be taken in all matters pertaining to the administration of the society

3. He shall preside over all meetings and conduct the meetings in a democratic manner.

15. Vice-President:

Vice President shall act on behalf of the president whenever the latter is indisposed or is absent from office or is unable to attend any meeting of the General Body or Executive committee, and regulate the proceedings thereof. When he acts on behalf of the president he shall have the liberty to exercise one original vote and in case of equality of votes, a casting vote.

16. Secretary & Treasurer

The Secretary & Treasurer shall manage the day to day affairs of the Society and meet the expenses in connection therewith subject to supervision, guidance and control of the Executive committee. He shall also convene meeting of Executive committee and also of the General Body and keep the minutes thereof.

17. Executive Committee Meetings

A meeting of the Executive committee members will be convened once in three months at a specified place and date after prior notice of 10 days. Quorum of meeting shall be 1/3 of the total membership of a executive whatever is less. All resolutions of the executive committee shall be carried out by a majority of votes. The president or in his absence the Vice-President or in the absence of both any member appointed by the members there present shall preside over the meeting and have a second or casting vote in case of equality of votes. A statement of accounts and a copy of the report shall be placed before the Executive Secretary & Treasurer.

18. Power of Executive Committee

The Executive Committee shall have the entire control management of the business and affairs of the society and shall have all such powers of the Society and in all such things to carry out the general objects of the society, as are, by the Small Society Societies Registration Act, 1975 not required to be exercised or done by the society in General Meeting.

19. The accounting year of the organization shall be commencing from its April to March. The accounts will be closed for the year ending and new accounts will be commenced for the next Accounting financial year.

20. The General Body shall appoint auditor or auditors as it deems fit. The accounts of the organisation shall be audited by a qualified auditor or auditors as per Sec.16(1) and rule 21(2) of the Societies Regn. Act.

21) Every member of the organisation can be entitled to get a copy of the rules and regulations audit of Income and Expenditure balance sheet etc on payment of one rupee per copy on written application to the Secretary.

ii) No fine shall be imposed for any breach of the provisions of the bye-laws by the members or officers.

22) 1. All moneys of the organisation shall be deposited to any anticorrupt bank as decided by the Executive committee of the organisation and will open in the name of the organisation

2. All deposits and withdrawals shall be made only by President

3. The Treasurer & Secretary can retain a sum of Rs.50/- (Not exceeding) for meeting of the urgent and unforeseen expenses, Exceeding that the amount shall be remitted to the bank.

23) 1. Normally the Annual General Meeting shall be held in a year within a period of three months after the expiry of the financial year, on or before the month of June each meeting shall be conducted the following business.

3. Appointment of Auditor or Auditors.

24) a) Any amendment, alteration or cancellation of the existing bye-laws shall be done only at General Meeting, Any amendment, alteration addition or cancellation of the constitution shall be taken only at the meeting duly convened for the purposes.

25) a) The Executive committee can convene extra ordinary General Meeting at any time with prior notice for 21 days for each meeting.

b) The Extra ordinary General Body Meeting shall be called when 1/3rd majority of members of the organization make requisition to convene such meeting, the executive committee shall call such meetings, with in one month from the date of receipt of such requisition.

c) If the extra ordinary General Body Meeting is not called in accordance with such requisition the requisitionists shall have power to call such meeting themselves.

26) If the quorum not formed for General body meeting, the General body meeting shall be postponed to next month, and in respect of the extra ordinary meeting, the above meeting shall be postponed to next month. The next meeting shall not be postponed again, the meeting shall be conducted with the members present. Every member may exercise his or her vote and in the event of its equality the President shall have the casting vote, Quorum of the meeting 1/3rd of the majority of the members present in person who are entitled to vote.

27) Special resolution shall be passed at a general body not less than 3/4 th of the majority of the members present in person, who are entitled to vote for the following purposes of.
