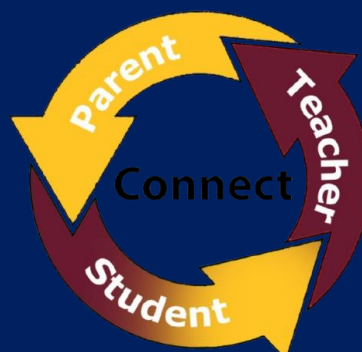
## ❖ English Excellence Awards
