➤ ORANGE DAY CELEBRATION

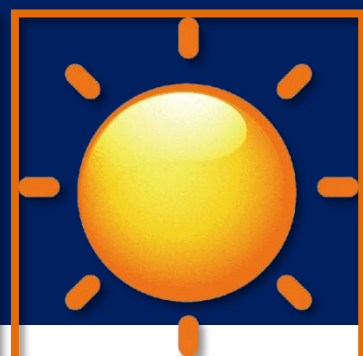

"Veetukoru Vinnyani"

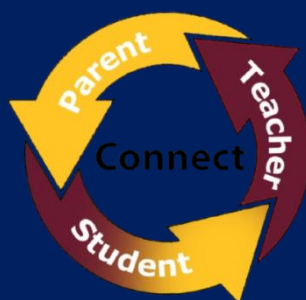
